RESOLUTION 2017-01-02

WHEREAS, the City of Scottsboro, Alabama's Police Department has certain items of personal property which are no longer needed for public or municipal purposes: and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56 of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of unneeded personal property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:
