The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on July 22, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Patrick Stewart. Invocation given by Council Attorney Stephen Kennamer. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Gary Stewart. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

RESOLUTION 2019-07-30

WHEREAS, The City of Scottsboro, Alabama's Fire Department is in need of a new 2019 Pickup Truck, and.

WHEREAS, Section 41-16-50 through 41-16-63, Code of Alabama 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to secure sealed bids; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-45-2(c) of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to accept bids by the adoption of a resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Scottsboro posted one (1) bid, mailed three (3) bids by US Postal Service, and received one (1) bid for the 2019 Pickup Truck.

Harbin Chevrolet \$40,771.50

Section 2. It is recommended by the Bid Review Committee that the bid be awarded to Harbin Chevrolet as the only responsible bidder that met specifications.

Mayor Robin Shelton commented that as of this afternoon the City had 5 knucklebooms up and running. He would also like to discuss adding a business license code for auto salvage at the next Work Session.

Council Member Greg Mashburn commented on the status of the knucklebooms.

Council Members Mike Ashburn, Richard Bailey, and Gary Stewart had nothing to report.
