The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on February 24, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

**RESOLUTION 2020-02-04**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Scottsboro, Alabama has certain property which are no longer needed for public or municipal purposes: and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-43-56 of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of unneeded personal property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

**Section 1.** That the following personal property owned by the City of Scottsboro, Alabama is not needed for public or municipal purposes:

± 1.85 acres of vacant land-East side of Clifford Drive, South of Veterans Drive

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Clerk and they hereby are, authorized and directed to dispose of the property owned by the City of Scottsboro described in Section 1, above, by conveying to the Commercial Development Authority to market and assist with commercial development.
