May 8, 2006**

The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met in regular session on May 8, 2006.

The roll was called with the following results:

City Clerk Gail Duffey and Attorney Stephen Kennamer were also present. Mayor Deason was attending an Alabama League of Municipalities meeting in Mobile. A Student Council Member, Zach Willis, from Ms. Amos' Democracy Class at Scottsboro High School sat with the Council.

The Council President stated a quorum was present and the meeting was open for the transaction of business.

The agenda was approved as prepared and amended by the Council President.

The minutes from the April 24, 2006 council meeting were read and approved as read.

ORDINANCE NO. 515

**AN ORDINANCE LEASING PROPERTY OWNED BY THE
CITY OF SCOTTSBORO AND OTHER MATTER WITH
RESPECT THERETO**

Ordinance 515 was introduced at the April 24, 2006 Council Meeting.

After said Ordinance had been discussed and considered in full by the Council it was moved by Council Member Matthew Hodges that said Ordinance be now placed upon its final passage and adoption. The motion was seconded by Council Member Jim Boatner. The question being put as to the adoption of said motion and the final passage and adoption of said Ordinance, the roll was called with the following results:

The Council President thereupon declared the motion carried and said Ordinance No. 515 passed and was adopted as introduced and read.

BID OPENING FOR THE ANDERSON ROAD SEWAGE PROJECT

The Waterworks, Sewer and Gas Board having requested bids for the Anderson Road sewage project through the Community Development Project, the following were received and opened prior to the Council Meeting.

Upon the recommendation of Roy Light, Sewer Board Manager and Stan Nelson, Project Engineer, motion was made by Council Member Jim Boatner and seconded by Council Member Buddy Simmons to award the bid to Lambert, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder that met specifications. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

The CDBG Grant was for only \$500,000.00. Sewer Board Manager Roy Light assured the Council that the Sewer Board would pay the balance.

Victor Manning, Emergency Management Agent, came before the Council and explained that the Council still had time to apply for a grant for sirens for weather alert. The grant was a 25% - 75% match and was for Outdoor Warning Sirens. Mr. Manning explained that the City should decide how many sirens were needed and apply by June 1, 2006.

BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE SCOTTSBORO SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT

Upon the recommendation of Council Member Buddy Simmons a motion was made by Council Member Simmons to amend the Solid Waste Department's budget in the amount of \$53,000.00. \$40,000.00 will be used to purchase new containers and \$13,000.00 will be used to hire a Secretary at the Solid Waste Department. \$13,000.00 is the amount needed for the remainder of this budget year. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

BID OPENING FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE OLD HANGER BUILDING AT THE AIRPORT

Having requested bids for the sale and removal of the Old Hanger Building at the Airport the following bid was received and opened prior to the Council Meeting.

JTH Grading and Demolition, Inc. agrees to:

- Remove metal building at Scottsboro Airport
- Does NOT include any concrete
- JTH Co. agrees to pay City of Scottsboro \$475.00 for metal building
- All materials to be removed from site

Motion was made by Council Member Buddy Simmons and seconded by Council Member Matthew Hodges to award the bid to JTH as the highest bidder that met specifications. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

The Council thanked everyone for coming out and commended the Street Department for cleaning up Highway 72 Overpass at Broad St.

The Council President thanked the Council for effort they put forth. He reminded the people that the Council was responsible for the City's money and that this Council was taking care of the City's money.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, motion was made by Council Member Buddy Simmons and seconded by Council Member Jim Helms that the meeting be adjourned. All voted aye.
