The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met in regular session on June 26, 2006.

The roll was called with the following results:

Margaret Daye having resigned from the Personnel Board, Council Member Matthew Hodges nominated Thomas Parker to be appointed to this Board. There being no other nominations motion was made by Council Member Jim Boatner and seconded by Council Member Jim Helms that the nomination be closed. All voted aye. Upon vote being taken to appoint Mr. Thomas Parker to fill the unexpired term of Margaret Daye, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried. Term to expire 02-26-07.

Ordinance No. 517 was introduced at the June 19, 2006 Council Meeting.

After said Ordinance had been discussed and considered in full by the Council it was moved by Council Member Jim Helms that said Ordinance be now placed upon its final passage and adoption. The motion was seconded by Council Member Jim Boatner. The question being put as to the adoption of said motion and the final passage and adoption of said Ordinance, the roll was called with the following results:

**AN APPROPRIATION TO CARVER PARK**

Upon the request of the citizens of the Carver Park Community motion was made by Council Member Jim Boatner and seconded by Council Member Matthew Hodges to appropriate \$10,000.00 for repairing and fixing up of Carver Park. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

Veronica Kelly, a participant at the Boys and Girls Club presented a sign she had designed to be placed at Carver Park. The Council asked Mayor Deason to see that a proper sign got made and installed at the park. The sign represents what the park means to the children at the Boys and Girls Club.

Any qualified elector who will have resided within the municipality for a period of at least 90 days on Election Day may qualify to run for office by filing the appropriate forms and paying any appropriate fees, as otherwise provided by law. If necessary, a run-off election will be held on Tuesday, September 12, 2006. Statement of candidacy forms will be available at the office of the City Clerk at the City Hall in Scottsboro beginning at 8:00 o'clock a.m. on July 5, 2006 and any qualified elector desiring to become a candidate in such election must file a duly sworn statement of candidacy in the office of the City Clerk by 5:00 o'clock p.m. on July 18, 2006.

All registered and qualified electors of the state who reside within the corporate limits of Scottsboro, Alabama, and have resided therein for 30 days or more immediately preceding the date of such election, and who are qualified to vote in the county precinct which embraces and covers that part of the corporate limits of said city in which the elector resides, will be authorized to participate in said election.

The polls will be opened at 7:00 a.m. and will close at 7:00 p.m. CST. The polling places shall be: Scottsboro Rec Com, 701 Houston Street.

Done this the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 2006.

Motion to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to hold an election was made by Council Member Matthew Hodges and seconded by Council Member Jim Helms. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

The Mayor and Council was pleased to see everyone out and asked that they all attend First Monday on the upcoming week end.

Attorney Kennamer advised Mr. Billy Jack Kirby that Clark Street was never approved as a subdivision street. He did explain the section of the street adjacent to the old Social Security building was a city street. Mr. Kennamer explained further that if there was any damage done by the city we will need to fix it.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, motion was made by Council Member Jim Boatner and seconded by Council Member Jim Helms that the meeting be adjourned. All voted aye.
