

**Minutes of a Meeting of the

The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama convened at Scottsboro, Alabama at 11:00 a.m. on September 13, 2006 in an adjourned session of the regular meeting held on September 11, 2006. On roll call the following answered:
