Having requested bids for the Streetscape Improvements on Willow and Houston the following were received and opened prior to the Council Meeting:

Upon the recommendation of the Bid Review Committee and CDG Engineers and Associates, motion was made by Council Member Matthew Hodges and seconded by Council Member Josephine Smith to award the bid to Clark Associates as the lowest responsible bidder that met specifications. Upon vote being taken the following voted aye: Council Members Matthew Hodges, Josephine Smith, Terry Thomas and Council President Keith Smith. The Council President declared the motion carried.

The Council President asked Street Superintendent Joe Rodgers and City Planner Curtis Davis to look at a ditch that runs from Willow Street down by the old Coke Plant and make a report to the Council.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, motion was made by Council Member Terry Thomas and seconded by Council Member Matthew Hodges that the meeting be continued to December 17, 2008 following the Work Session. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye.
