March 3, 2008

The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met in an adjourned session from the February 25, 2008 Council Meeting on this the 3rd day of March 2008 in the Council Chambers of Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by the Council President and the roll was called with the following results:

ANIMAL CONTROL CAPITAL OUTLAY BUDGET RE-DESIGNATED

Upon the recommendation of Police Chief Ralph Dawe, motion was made by Council Member Josephine Smith and seconded by Council Member Buddy Simmons to allow the Capitol Outlay in the Animal Control budget to be used for one new truck rather than two used trucks and a cage. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

**APPROVAL TO PURCHASE COMPUTER SERVER
FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Upon the recommendation of the Police Chief, motion was made by Council Member Buddy Simmons and seconded by Council Member Terry Thomas to approve up to \$7500.00 to purchase a computer server for the Police Department. Funds to come from the Courts/Jail Account. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

**ELECTRONIC CONTROL DEVICE (THE TAISER POLICY)
APPROVED FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Upon the request of Police Chief Ralph Dawe, motion was made by Council Member Terry Thomas and seconded by Council Member Josephine Smith to approve the Electronic Control Device (the Taiser Policy) as presented by the Chief and to be included in the Scottsboro Police Department Policy and Procedure Manual. The policy is on file in the Police Department. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

**APPROVAL TO PURCHASE A TERMINAL SERVER
FOR THE COURTS DEPARTMENT**

Upon the request of the Courts, motion was made by Council Member Matthew Hodges and seconded by Council Member Terry Thomas to approve the purchase of a terminal server for the Courts Department. The server is to be purchased from the Jail/Courts Account. Upon vote being taken, all voted aye. The Council President declared the motion carried.

ELBERT C. DAUGHTERY APPOINTED AS AIRPORT MANAGER

Upon the recommendation of the Airport Board, Council Member Terry Thomas nominated Elbert C. Daughtery to be appointed as Airport Manager. There were no other nominations. Upon a roll call vote the following voted aye. Council Members Terry Thomas, Matthew Hodges, Josephine Smith, Buddy Simmons and Council President Keith Smith. The Council President declared Elbert C. Daughtery appointed as the Airport Manager effective immediately.
