The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on February 12, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Tony Wallingsford. Invocation was given by City Attorney Stephen Kennamer. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Gary Stewart. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

**RESOLUTION 2018-02-05**
