The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on February 26, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

**CONSIDER CITY EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT INCENTIVE
FOR 2018**

The incentive would be \$500 per year of service for any employees eligible to retire by December 31, 2018. Employees will have until April 30, 2018 to submit the reward form. **CONSIDER SURPLUS OF HOOD VENT SYSTEM TO THE
COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

Council President Wallingsford called for a motion to approve the surplus of the old hood vent system, previously at the Boys & Girls Club, to be given to the Commercial Development Authority for disposal. Motion was made by Council Member Jessica Butler and seconded by Council Member Keith Smith. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
