The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on January 27, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Patrick Stewart. Formalities were given at the preceding Work Session. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

**CONSIDER RESOLUTION 2020-01-02: AWARD BID FOR
RECONSTRUCTION OF LEQUIRE DRIVE**

RESOLUTION 2020-01-02

WHEREAS, The City of Scottsboro, Alabama is in need of a reconstruction of Lequire Drive, and.

WHEREAS, Section 41-16-50 through 41-16-63, Code of Alabama 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to secure sealed bids; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-45-2(c) of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to accept bids by the adoption of a resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Scottsboro posted one (1) bid and received two (2) bids for the reconstruction of Lequire Drive.

Wiregrass Construction Company Inc.	\$335,371.25
Reed Contracting Services Inc.	\$294,800.26

Section 2. It is recommended by the Bid Review Committee that the bid be awarded to Reed Contracting Services as the lowest responsible bidder that met specifications.
